UNITED 4 CHILD CARE A collaborative solution to the child care crisis.



Lack of affordable child care continues to be one of Southern Maine's greatest workforce challenges. A recent United Way survey revealed that it is the **primary obstacle to employment for 84% of households** where at least one adult is not working.

High-quality, accessible child care allows parents to pursue careers and education and provides children with crucial cognitive and social development. In short, child care is the foundation for a thriving economy and community.

THE Solution

United Way of Southern Maine is bringing the community together to address this crisis by launching a new non-profit, United 4 Child Care (U4CC). U4CC collaborates with local businesses and community partners to provide affordable, accessible child care to Southern Maine employees, particularly those that are ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed).
